





Scott Mitchell Scott Mitchell studied Jazz guitar at Laurentian University and has been in theatre and performing live throughout Ontario for over 20 years. In the fall of 2000 Scott Mitchell, along with several other local musicians formed cover/original act "My Band". In 2003, after performing for a number of years, they released their debut disc The Blaney Era. The first ECD to be released from a Northern Ontario Artist, The Blaney Era, enjoyed radio play in Northern Ontario and some success abroad.

With this success, the original material became their focus, and this success called for an increased commitment needed to maintain it. Looking to separate themselves from the cover shows they once performed, the band changed their name to Another Story in reference to the new direction of their careers. Another Story's music has been described as "...where Matchbox 20 meets 3 doors down." Since their beginning Another Story has done over 1000 live shows, appeared on 4 soundtracks, 4 compilation CD's, done over 100 benefit concerts, released 2 full length albums and shared stages with Ashley MacIsaac, Barney Bentall, Default, The Mudmen, The 70's all star band and April Wine to name a few.

While the release of their second full length CD, Volume 1, in October 2008 did not achieve much local success it was very successful in Europe, Asia and Australia. The band was offered a deal to tour the US but declined and decided to retire from the road.

Scott Mitchell can still be found playing local establishments in Sudbury as a solo artist occasionally getting the band back together for special events.





Rusted Spoons

Meet John: With a musical journey that began at 17, John Serre seamlessly weaved through genres like garage, punk, metal, and folk, showcasing fluency in various instruments. His projects led him to tour France, performing at renowned venues like Paris' La Batofar with Born and engaging over 300 people at a city function in Elliot Lake with Kaiser North. Currently, He channels his diverse influences into Rusted Spoons, a bluesy, jazzy, funky, punk duo. Imagine the musical offspring of Amy Winehouse, Brody Dalle, Wes Montgomery, Bo Diddly, Howling Wolf, and Cake - that's the sound created by Rusted Spoons.

Meet Elizabeth: My name is Elizabeth. I'm originally from Niagara Falls and have been living in Elliot Lake for 13 years, and Sudbury for a few years in between. I've been singing for as long as I can remember and it's always been a passion of mine. I started off singing karaoke until I was in my late 30's, when I began singing at open mics. Along with a great guitarist John who I met at a local open mic, we formed the duo Rusted Spoons. We play many genres of music with a focus on blues, funk, jazz and soul.






